

Allendale Primary School June 2018 Newsletter

We have got a very busy last half term coming up and I have included some details and dates of events and trips which involve various classes.

Our Bag2School collection is on **Thursday 21st June**. All donations of clothing etc. can be left at the office anytime.

No news as yet on Miss White's baby; s/he is being very reluctant to make an appearance. As I am now a full time teacher in Lapwing Class until the end of term, I regret that I cannot meet with parents in a morning before school and will endeavour to reply to any correspondence as quickly as I can.

We held a very successful coffee afternoon to showcase the children's work on aspects of the Allen Valleys to celebrate Northumberland day. Many thanks to all the friends and family who donated cakes and attended the event. I would just like to clarify a misunderstanding regarding taking children home early when we have events in school. Legally the children should be in school until 3.30pm, which is our official home time; however, as the majority of children do have parents or a family member in attendance, I apply some discretion to allow children to leave slightly earlier, from 3.00pm and the class teacher must be informed. Not all children can have a family attend so activities are still going on in classrooms during these events.

There are quite a few sporting events as well as regular PE lessons; PE kit should be worn by all children, navy blue polo shirt, navy blue shorts, navy blue hoodie, (optional), dark tracksuit / jogging bottoms, (optional for outdoor PE) and trainers / sand shoes. We have a few items in lost property, please name your child's uniform and sports shoes.

I know that children and parents will be keen to know which class their child will be in from September; I am working on it. School budgets are extremely tight and without the support of the PTFA and yourselves in attending events, we would not be able to offer the trips, visitors and workshops free of charge as we currently do. We will be able to maintain 5 classes from September with the same level of Teaching Assistant support as now. I am just waiting for confirmation of new children joining our school before finalising the classes.

We are performing a Summer show at the end of term. A lot of time and effort goes into our shows and the children have just started to learn some of the songs. We may be asking for your help in producing some of the costumes, however, we do not expect any parents to buy something especially for this, a bit of imagination and creativity can go a long way! There are also 2 evening performances which we would ideally like all children to attend but if this is not possible, please could you let a member of staff know so we can adapt things as necessary.
