<u>English</u>

In English we will be linking our work to our topic of Ancient Greece. This will include looking at Ancient Greek Myths and legends, fables and writing non chronological reports.

<u>Science</u>

In Science Lapwings will be learning about the Uses of Everyday Materials, including wood, plastic, metal, glass, brick, paper and cardboard. The children then go on to compare the suitability of different everyday materials for different purposes. They will explore how objects made of some everyday materials can change shape and how the recycling process is able to reuse some everyday materials numerous times. The children will also learning about new discoveries which have made over time.

<u>PSHEE</u>

Healthy living will be our focus for PSHEE this term. This includes healthy living and lifestyles, but also focuses on mental health and wellbeing. <u>PE</u>

In PE the children will be working on Socially Distanced Multi Skills. PE lessons will take place outside as much as possible and the children will work on developing a range of skills, including running, jumping, throwing and catching. Who will be a Lapwing Olympic champion?



<u>Maths</u>

In Maths the children will begin by looking at place value and move on to develop their knowledge and understanding of addition and subtraction, multiplication and division fractions, measure and shape.

<u>Topic</u>

In our topic we will begin by looking at modern day Greece. We will look at things such as climate, food and geographical features. Then we will the look at aspects of life in Ancient Greece including clothing, housing and Greek Gods. We will look at how Ancient Greece influences our life today, for example the Olympic Games. We will create our own Art and DT based on Ancient Greek designs.

ICT

In ICT this term the children will use programmes to create posters and information leaflets relating to our topic of Ancient Greece. The children will be taught how to edit the colour, size and type of font as well as how to copy and paste pictures from the internet. There will also be opportunities for the children to use the internet to research our topic.
