Art/DT

The children will learn about the life of the painter J. M. W. Turner and recreate their own painting of the sea influenced by his style using a range if media.

Next half term, they will use a variety of skills and techniques to build a lighthouse.

Humanities

Lapwing class will use world maps, atlases and globes to locate oceans and seas found around the World as well as learning about marine life found in different ocean habitats. The children will learn about Grace Darling, a lighthouse Keeper's daughter who played an important role in rescuing survivors of a ship wreck.

French

In this unit of work Lapwing Class will learn to greet each other, exchange names, ask how someone is, count to 10 and say how they are.

PΕ

Here, the children will learn some gymnastic shapes and use them in different ways. They will put together sequences involving a variety of body shapes and gymnastic movements. They will be creating routines and sequences in pairs and groups.



PSHEE

Our PSHE topic this term is all about keeping safe. The children will be encouraged to recognise risk in everyday situations and what actions to take to minimise harm. They will learn ways to keep safe in different environments. They will also learn basic rules for keeping safe online, including what is meant by personal information and what should be kept private as well as the importance of telling a trusted adult id they come across something that scares them.

Music

Using the Charanga resources, children will earn about beat, rhythm, using their voices and percussion instruments through writing songs.

Science

Our topic this term is 'Animals and their Habitats'. In this unit of work, children will learn about a variety of habitats and the plants and animals that live there. They will learn to tell the difference between things that are living, things that are dead and things that have never been alive. They will make observations of a local habitat and the creatures that live there. The children will research a range of global habitats and how the living things that live there are suited to their environments.

RE

In RE the children will be learning about Buddhism. They will find out where Buddhism originated, about special places and key festivals in Buddhist life. The children will also learn about symbols in Buddhism, the Buddhist holy book and the main beliefs held by Buddhists.
