Topic - India

Geography

The pupils will continue to develop their knowledge and understanding of Geography through a study of India. They will look at the physical and human geography of the country and make comparisons with places they know in the British Isles. We will be finding out more the information shown in maps as well as discovering more about Indian culture, religion and food.

History

The pupils will continue to develop their historical knowledge through our topic on India. We will be finding out about British influence in India as well as the influence India has had on Britain and the world.

PE

In gymnastics we will focus on balances, rolls, movement and sequences both on the floor and apparatus. The children will create sequences that include changes of level and speed, and use different body shapes. They will work individually and in small groups, with the aim of showing as much control, precision and performance as possible. The apparatus sessions will help to develop confidence and to extend the skills they have developed during floorwork. The pupils will develop their ball skills and knowledge of teamwork and competition through rugby based activities. After half-term, the children will undertake a programme of dance activities which will be linked to our topics and culminate in a dance festival.

Art / Design

Through topic work, the pupils will undertake a range of art and design activities, including looking at examples of Indian art and recreating this using different media. We will be experimenting with colour and detail in painting as well as using wider variety of materials to add texture.

<u>French</u>
