

### Art/DT

- The children will learn about the life of the painter J.M.W. Turner and recreate their own painting of the sea influenced by his style.
- Recreate their own ocean habitat in 3D.
- To use a variety of skills and techniques to build a lighthouse.

### Humanities

- To learn about the Grace Darling, a lighthouse Keeper's daughter who played an important role in rescuing survivors of a ship wreck.
- To use world maps, atlases and globes to locate oceans and seas found around the World.
- Learn about marine life found in different ocean habitats found around the World.

### Outdoor Learning

- Use the outside environment to solve problems and participate in group tasks to improve speaking and listening skills and develop confidence.
- Investigate the mini-beasts living in the school grounds and the food chains they are parts of.

### Literacy

- Research marine animals using non-fiction texts and the internet and write their own non-fiction
- Spelling, punctuation & grammar.
- Read Write Inc - practise and develop phonic knowledge, reading skills and writing skills through a variety of texts.
- Read and write their own recipes and potions
- Develop their use of adjectives and descriptive noun phrases through reading and writing poems and descriptions of characters and settings.

### Science

- Learn about food chains found in a variety of habitats including the oceans and the school grounds.
- Explore the school grounds to investigate and record the minibeasts found there.
- Learn about what plants need to grow, carry out experiments and plant seeds and observe them growing.
