Science

In Science, Lapwings will be learning about **Rocks**. The children will learn about natural and human-made rocks and the different kinds of natural rocks. They will use their investigative and observational skills to group rocks by their properties and identify simple similarities and differences. They will also record their findings. The children will find out about the difference between a bone and a fossil and find out about the work of Mary Anning.

PSHE & RE

We will be using the Friends Resilience programme. The children will learn to recognise their feelings and emotions and develop their understanding of how they impact on actions and behaviour.

In RE will be looking at Christianity:

Lifestyles and Communities.

PE

In PE the children will be learning about **Invasion Games** such as football. They will be developing the skills needed to succeed in these games, such as attacking and defending. They will discover why keeping possession is so important and how to keep possession through dribbling and passing.



Autumn Term 2021

Computing

In computing this term we will look at e-safety and how to keep safe on line. Children will also use programmes to create posters and information leaflets relating to our topic of The Romans. The children will be taught how to edit the colour, size and type of font as well as how to copy and paste pictures from the internet. There will also be opportunities for the children to use the internet to research our topic.

Topic

In our topic on **The Romans** we will look at the Roman Empire and how the Army enabled it to spread so far. We will look at different aspects of Roman life, the invasion of Britain and how the Romans impacted on life in Britain.

We will also link our **D&T** and **Art** work to our topic. In geography we will look at **Where We Live**, including the Roman legacy in the local area. Here, the children will use simple fieldwork and observational skills to study the geography of their school and its grounds and the key human and physical features of its surrounding environment.

Music

In Music we will be following the Charanga programme. The children will learn about beat, pulse and rhythm and have opportunities to explore using voice, body percussion and musical instruments.
