Information texts share fascinating facts about our world! Using the theme of Asian animals, children will explore the textual features of writing narrative non-fiction and non-chronological reports. They will be able to write statements, questions and exclamations and understand how to use the possessive apostrophe.

Grammar focus:

Year 2

- 1. Use familiar and new punctuation correctly: full stops, capital letters, exclamation marks and questions marks
- 2. Use sentences that have different forms: statement, question and exclamation
- 3. Use the present and past tenses correctly and consistently

Year 3

1. Indicate possession using the possessive apostrophe with plural nouns Use present perfect forms of verbs

Grammar focus:

Year 2
