We're always very pleased to hear about the achievements of our pupils out of school. Emily Lenton has been competing this year at Benchrest Target shooting. This is Emily's first year of shooting and competitions and she has been competing in the UK National league; the league is based on the type of rifle shot, NOT the age of experience of the competitor, so she shoots against all the adults (she is the youngest by many years).

Emily has managed to finish 2nd in the Heavy Gun class at 600 yards. This records her 4 best results from 6. Her crowning moment was an outright win of one of the League shoots outright, beating several people who have previously shot for Great Britain.

Emily will be shooting in the Heavy Gun class at 1000 yards this summer (that's over half a mile).
